

Crusades (XI-XIII)



«At the beginning of the XI century, new Muslim conquerors, the Seljuk Turks, invaded the Middle East from Central Asia. They received this name by the name of their leader Seljuk. Having defeated the Arabs, the leader of the Seljuks forced the caliph to give him the title of "Sultan of the East and West". After the capture of Palestine, Jerusalem with the Christian shrines located in it was in the hands of the Seljuks. The main one was the Church of the Holy Sepulcher. In 1071, the Seljuks invaded Asia Minor, defeated the Byzantines and captured their emperor. Byzantium turned to the Christian countries of the West for help.

The response came from the city of Clermont in France.

The need for crusades was formulated by Pope Urban II after the end of the Council of Clermont in March 1095. He determined the economic reason for the Crusades: the European land is not able to feed all the people living on it, therefore, in order to preserve the Christian population, it is necessary to conquer rich lands in the East. Religious argumentation concerned the inadmissibility of keeping the shrines of Christianity, primarily the Church of the Holy Sepulcher, in the hands of infidels».
